

How to connect your DIGI **Internet Box to** the internet, easily and quickly?

Just follow these 3 steps.

Step 1. Installation and connection

Connect the power supply 3 of the WiFi router. 🕦

Connect one end of the Ethernet cable 2 to the "WAN" port of the router and the other end to the Ethernet (LAN) port of the ONT

If you have contracted our landline service and wish to use a telephone, connect it to the Phonel connector of the WiFi router

Step 3. Get connected to the internet

You can connect in two different ways:

Contents of the box





- You can use the wireless WiFi connection as long as your device has a wireless adapter
- The network and password are located on the back of the WiFi router.

Connect an Ethernet cable 2 to the computer's Ethernet input and to one of the router's connectors: LANI or LAN2. Turn on the computer and the LAN indicator light will turn green after a few seconds. This means that the connection is successful.

Please note that the wifi connection speed is lower than the speed provided by the Ethernet cable and depends, among other factors, on the distance you are from the router and the connection speed of your device.

Press the Reset button (Top button in the back) of the WiFi router for at least 10 seconds and then release it. After 30 seconds it will return to factory settings.
